Course Objective This course “WSQ Productivity Improvement using Mobile Devices – Level 2” is designed to enable learners to improve workplace productivity through the effective use of mobile devices such as tablets and smartphones. Learners will learn to identify the importance of productivity, facilitate the implementation of mobile productivity tools, review and assess productivity techniques, and provide feedback on process improvements. The course covers various mobile applications and tools that support productivity and process optimization in the workplace.

 - Review tablet/smartphone techniques and tools for workplace productivity improvement
 - Track productivity performance through cloud storage and synchronisation methods
 - Methods of data collection

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- Common productivity tools (e.g. DBS PayLah!, GrabPay, Carousell, Lazada, Shopee)
- Section 4: Feedback on productivity and process
 - Provide feedback of using tablet/smartphone to improve productivity and processes
