- Little or no formal education needed.

Course Objective This course “WSQ Washroom Cleaning – level 1” help to equip learners with the necessary knowledge, skills, and procedures to effectively and safely clean and maintain washroom facilities. Upon completion of this course, learners will be proficient in identifying various washroom surfaces and facilities, utilizing appropriate cleaning tools, equipment, and chemicals, and adhering to safety and organizational guidelines. Learners will be able to perform thorough cleaning tasks, replenish consumables, manage waste disposal to ensure a hygienic and well-maintained washroom environment.

(This course is only for the low wage workers in the PWM-Cleaning Sector)

Learning Outcomes LO1: Able to identify hard floor surfaces and facilities in a washroom so as to recognise their characteristics that are relevant to cleaning

LO2: Able to collect/prepare PPE, safety signage, cleaning tools, equipment, supplies and chemicals prior to start of cleaning activities

LO3: Able to put on appropriate PPE and display safety signage

LO4: Able to replenish consumable items in washrooms

LO5: Able to apply appropriate methods and procedures to remove dust, soilage and spillage from washroom surfaces

LO6: Able to apply appropriate methods and procedures to clean toilet walls/partitions and surfaces with high user contact

LO7: Able to apply appropriate methods and procedures to clean toilet floors

LO8: Able to collect and dispose waste

LO9: Able to perform post-cleaning checks and reporting
